

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2017 Lockhart State School will receive

\$124,355*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the PM reading levels of year 3 students from 100% students below level 20 in year 2 to 50% above level 20 in year 3
- Increase M200 word recognition in year 3 from 1/15 students in year 2 (2016) to 100% of students in Year 3 2017
- Support 100% of year 4 students to be reading at PM benchmark (Level 30)
- Increase the % of year 6 students from 10% at or above stanine 3 numeracy (year 5, 2016) to 20% year 6, 2017
- Increase the year 6 students reading at or above PROBE reading level 12 from 40% (year 5 2016) to 80%
- Support Prep students to improve reading - 50% at or above PM level 5
- Support Prep students – 100% students to recognise M100 words
- Support Year 1 students to improve reading - 100% at or above PM level 10
- Support Year 2 students to improve reading – 100% at or above PM level 12
- Support Year 6 students to transition to boarding school in 2018 with 100% retention

Our initiatives include

- Reading SWAT Team Initiative and Whole School Reading Program
- School Based Transitions Program to support Transition Services
- Whole school Maths Program
- 5 Week Data Sweep and Whole School Assessment Schedule
- 1 Teacher per 10 students
- 2 Teacher Aides minimum in every class
- Teacher Aide PD and capacity building

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ staff with high Standard Australian English and reading skills for the Reading Swat Team
approx. \$36000
- Employ local community members as Teacher Aides in all classes
approx. \$58335 (TA employment supplemented by additional school funding)
- Employ school based and funded Transition Officer to liaise with parents, Year 6 Teacher, Year 6 students, Principal and QLD Transition Officers to maximise transitions to boarding school success for year 6 students
approx. \$40000
